Print out (icon @ very bottom of page) -In "Other" box, lower R-hand corner write, "COVID-19" or "Coronavirus" -Return to General Info Page. Click on the 3<sup>rd</sup> tab for "Ordering and Collection" specifics</p>	<p>Nasopharyngeal swab (swab on flexible plastic shaft)</p> <p>Insert swab into UTM (universal transport media) Make sure top seals</p>	<p>Write: "COVID-19" or "Coronavirus" on "Other" (lower right hand corner) of Virology Requisition Form**</p> <p>Provide provider phone &amp; fax #'s</p>	<p>Store sample at 2-8 degrees C (ice pack). Ship immediately to lab. If anticipate travel time more than 24 hours, use dry ice (preferred).</p>	<p>Call Fed Ex</p>	<p>Presumptive Positives will be forwarded to the PHL, Shoreline.
