



How to become a member of the WARM Review Committee:

The WARM Review Committee shall be comprised of actively practicing midwives within Washington State who are members of WARM. Members shall embody the following characteristics: truthfulness, fairness, kindness, integrity, trustworthiness, compassion, ability to maintain confidentiality and a non-judgmental perspective.

Members of the review committee will be involved with both peer reviews and incident reviews (IR). The duties will include but are not limited to- developing standards for these meetings, providing necessary paperwork to participants, ensuring we adhere to state CQIP standards, leading incident reviews, reviewing IR findings and determining IR outcome recommendations.

We have a brief application for you to complete and a few important questions we'd like to have answered by two peer references (one of which must be a WARM midwife who is actively practicing in WA state) in order to verify you meet our criteria for this committee. Once submitted, your placement on the committee will be approved by the WARM board.
